## January 20 Meeting

Come join us for the first meeting of the new year, to learn about bird banding from experts, Richard and Brenda Keith. The Keiths started volunteering at the Kalamazoo Nature Center in the 80's. They now work with other researchers collecting various samples from birds for study. Brenda has taken blood, feather and fecal samples, as well as helped Rich collect thousands of ticks from birds before they are released. Samples are used in important research on West Nile Virus, Avian Influenza and the spread of Deer Ticks and Lyme disease in Southwest Michigan.

Besides banding birds, Rich and Brenda also work on other related research projects such as the Michigan Breeding Bird Atlas I and II, winter feeder surveys and Christmas Bird Counts.

Please plan to attend and learn some new valuable information about our backyard visitors.
